

## **TRANSNATIONAL COOPERATION NETWORK YES for "Social Entrepreneurship for Youth and Youth NGOs"**

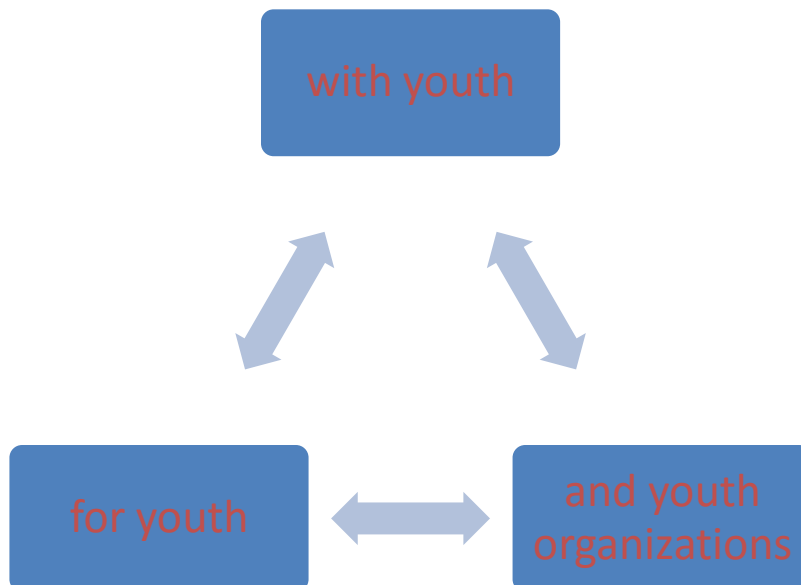
### *GUIDELINES*

The main hot questions are – We are doing enough for young people and for Youth NGOs/NGOs focused on Youth? How can we support them through social economy/social entrepreneurship across Europe?

These are the reasons for creating this Transnational Cooperation Network: YESNet, as a tool of stimulating Social Entrepreneurship for YOUTH and for Youth NGOs.

#### **MISSION:**

To put the YOUTH as the main base of a sustainable society and therefore to create a space for supporting social entrepreneurship:



The Network should be an open space for pro-actively addressing issues of common interest - relating to the challenges of youth development within the nowday and future world.

1. The YESNet has not a juridical form and a formal structure.
2. It is an online network open to any organization, institution, public authority or expert who adhere to the principles and the mission of YESNet only based on voluntary basis and free will. The membership is free of charge, there is no fee for adhering to the network.
3. It is created within the Erasmus+ Project: "YES for Entrepreneurial Youth NGOs, YES for Millennials Changers" implemented by Association of Consultants and Experts on Social Economy - ACE-ES Romania in partnership with Centro Superior de Formacion EUROPA SUR (Spain) and bbw gGmbH (Germany).
4. The members of YESNet could belong to the following types: NGOs; public authorities, including local and regional institutions; public and private "not for profit" foundations; other "for profit" partners promoting "not for profit" activities; experts and professionals (individual members).
5. The work principles for an efficient and relevant partnership among all the members of YESNet are:
  - a) Respect;
  - b) Transparency;

c) Responsibility and commitment;

d) Openness and active participation.

6. Sort of collaborative activities within the YESNet may include:

- Programs and projects focused on social economy and social entrepreneurship;
- Information, methodology and best practice exchanges; multiplication and dissemination of expertise;
- Research and learning activities;
- Campaigns;
- Thematic sub-groups;
- Other forms as agreed.

7. Each member of YESNet holds a position of equality; thus an equal important involvement and participation responsibility is to be developed among all partners.

8. The working language within the network is English.
